PROMISE OF PAYMENT

The dancer/parent agrees to pay all competition, convention (if applicable), hotel (if applicable), costume, and other related fees by the date set by South Georgia Dance Company. **If you would like your monthly fee deducted each month from your parent portal, please add a bank account or card on your parent portal. If you do not, then payments are due NO LATER than the 5th of each month. If you are late on 1 payment and do not have a card on file, it will then be mandatory that you do so. I am having to get strict on late fees, so if you have not paid by the 6th of that month, a 10% late fee will be charged to your account. Just communicate with us!**

CLASS PLACEMENT

The dancer must have at least 1 FULL year of dance experience from SGDC and/or invited or approved by the studio owner.

SOLOS, DUOS, TRIOS, SMALL GROUPS

- Solo: \$495
 - Includes choreography, videos of choreography, cut music, 3 hours of practice one on one with choreographer (can be split in 1 hour segments, 45 min segments, or 30 minute segments) **Costume is priced separately
 - If you want or need more than the 3 hours allotted with your choreographer you will have to purchase the time with them. This is to ensure each dancer is practicing on their own and taking their dances seriously.
 - 1 hour package \$50 (can be split into 30 min segments)
 - 2 hour package \$100 (can be split into 30 min segments)
 - 3 hour package \$150 (can be split into 45 min or 30 min segments)
- Duo: \$395 per dancer

**Nationals will not be mandatory. We will consider Nationals on a dance by dance basis.

DRESS CODE

All dancers are required to wear ALL BLACK to company classes. This includes:

- Black leotards, fitted shorts, skirts, leggings, tanks, or sports bras
- Hair pulled back off the face

- Company jackets (\$65) are required at all events/competitions

OTHER PERFORMANCES

Other events may arise within the community as a performance opportunity for our competition teams. These events will be announced as they present themselves. Optional performance and learning opportunities will be provided throughout the year, but they will not be required for all dancers. These may or may not include travel. Solos/duos/trios and small groups may have additional performance opportunities noted in separate contracts.

EXTRA PRACTICES

We will have extra practices for competition team dancers. You will be given notice in advance. These practices may take place on Saturdays, Sundays, or school holidays. We try to keep extra practices to a minimum, but they are necessary for large production numbers involving multiple classes. These extra practices are mandatory. These extra practices are included in your registration fee.

MONTHLY TUITION: Please read carefully! We are doing things differently this year.

Competition rates and costume rates have increased significantly over the past 2 years. I have been trying to keep costs as minimal as possible, but there is only so much I can do. To keep your monthly costs down I have decided to break the financial contract down to a 12 month payment plan. Please see the schedule below:

May: Registration is \$45 (covers recital fees)

June: **\$50 solo, duo, trio, small group fee deposit** if your dancer is wanting to do one. If they decide they do not want to do one, we will credit this \$50 back to your account. This is to ensure choreographer scheduling and planning.
